



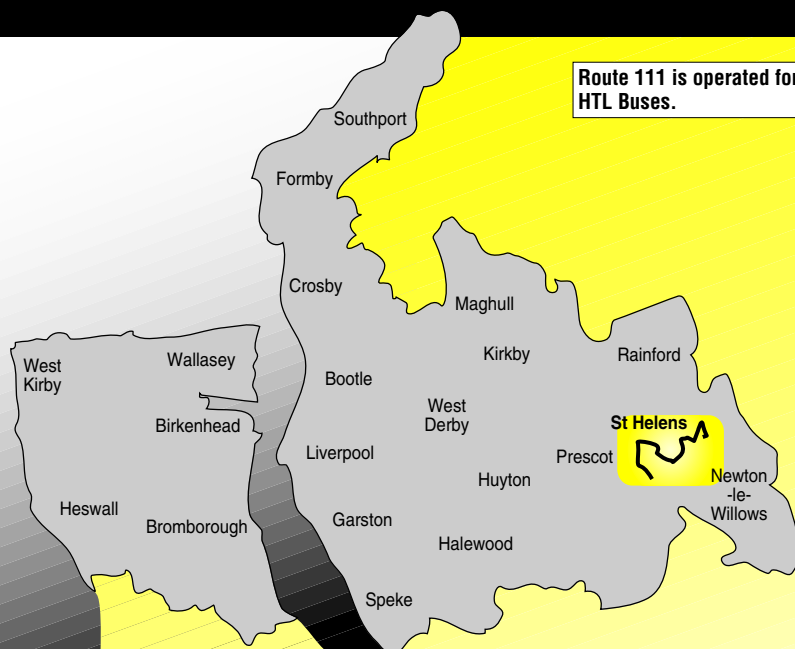

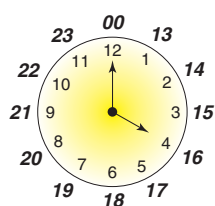
## Welcome to your new bus timetable

Merseytravel **does not** operate buses. Bus services in Merseyside are run by private companies. We subsidise bus services that the private bus companies do not provide, such as early morning, late evening or industrial journeys. These services are shown in timetables as “**Merseytravel Bus Services**” and are shown by the symbol .

## What this timetable contains

This leaflet contains all route descriptions and times provided by the bus company who operates service **111**. Other services may operate along all or part of this route with different bus numbers. Customers should refer to the “**Guide to Public Transport in St Helens**” map or ring **Traveline** on **0870 608 2 608** for full details.

## The 24 hour clock




The 24 hour clock is used in our timetables to avoid confusion between am and pm times. Use the clock face diagram shown on the left to convert between 12 and 24 hour clocks. When a time is shown, the first two numbers are the hour and the second two are the minutes. Here are some examples:

8am becomes 0800, midday becomes 1200, 3.20pm becomes 1520 and midnight becomes 0000

The time on the clock, could be shown as 0400 (morning) or 1600 (afternoon).

## Where does my bus go?

A description and map of the bus routes in this timetable, showing the timing points along the route, are included in this booklet. To help with timing point locations, a numbered box (eg ) is shown on the map at various points along the route. This refers to timing points shown on the timetable pages.

## How to use this timetable

- Turn to the page showing the direction of your journey, the day that you want to travel (eg Monday to Friday, Saturday or Sunday) and the bus company operating on that route.
- Each row of numbers represents one bus journey and the times at specific locations along the route. Look for your nearest departure and destination points in the left hand column. *(Some timing points may be shown in italics to indicate that the times along that line are for guidance only and were not provided by the bus company.)*
- Read across the page from your departure point until you find a time that is convenient for you. The arrival time of that journey at (or nearest to) your chosen destination is shown down the column.

**We can't show departure or arrival times for every bus stop - otherwise the timetable would be too big to print in booklet form**, so you may need to adjust your times accordingly.

Always remember to look for any route numbers, codes or notes that may apply to your journey, shown at the top of the column, as these may affect your travel plans.

## Bank and Public Holiday services

Many bus services change over Bank/Public holiday periods. You are advised to check with **Traveline** on **0870 608 2 608** for details of services that will operate.

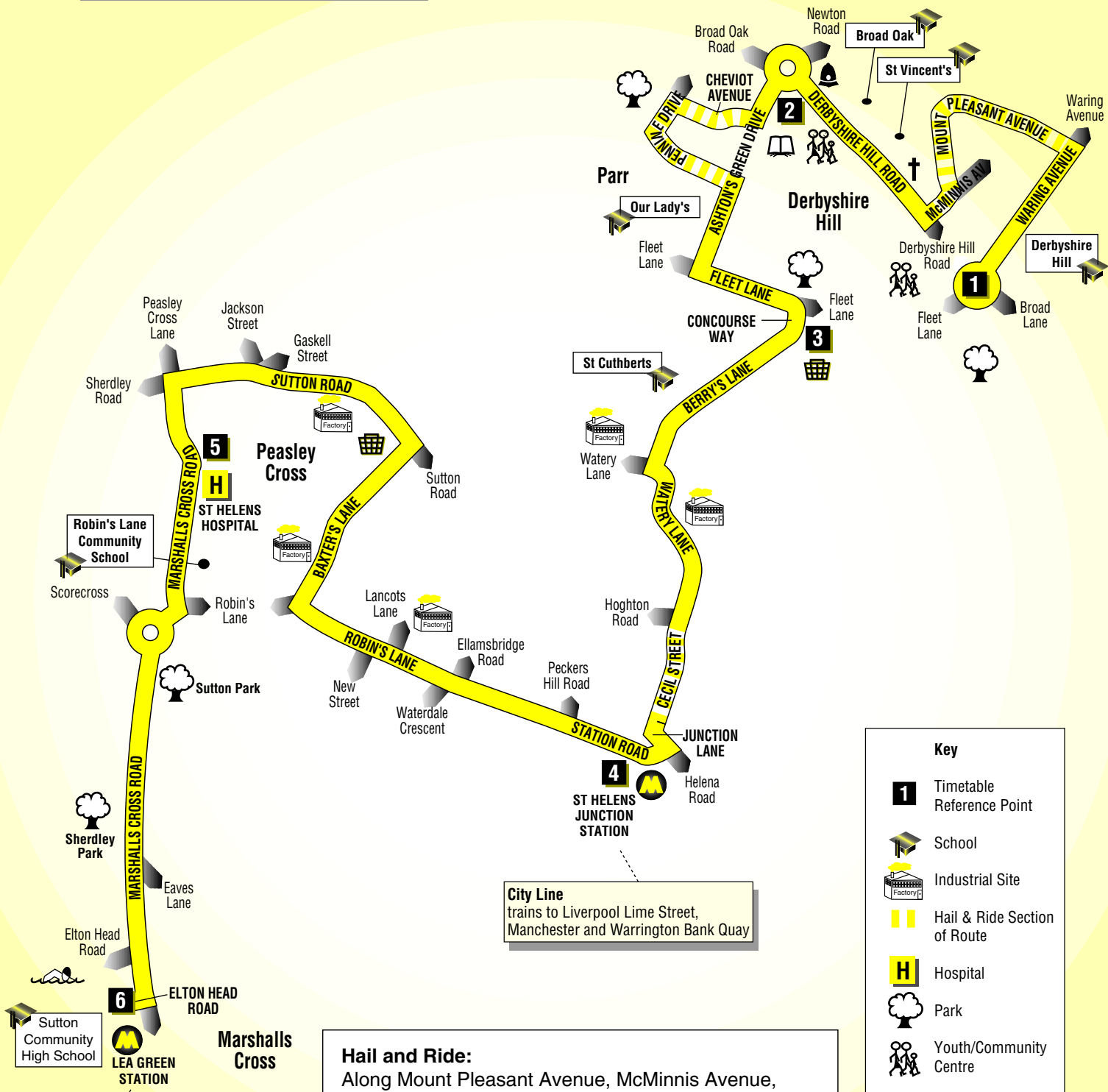

**Hail and Ride:**  
Along Mount Pleasant Avenue, McMinnis Avenue, Cheviot Avenue, Pennine Drive and Cecil Street this service offers the 'Hail & Ride' facility. Passengers can get on or off the bus anywhere along these roads, **providing the bus driver thinks it is safe to do so.** If you wish to get on the bus please give a clear hand signal to the bus driver. If you wish to get off the bus please tell the bus driver in good time. Please avoid main road junctions, crossings and bends in the road.

## Route description

**Route 111 from** PARR (DERBYSHIRE HILL ROAD/FLEET LANE) via Waring Avenue, Mount Pleasant Avenue, McMinnis Avenue, Derbyshire Hill Road, Ashton's Green Drive, Cheviot Avenue, Pennine Drive, Ashton's Green Drive, Fleet Lane, Concourse Way, Berry's Lane, Watery Lane, Cecil Street, Junction Lane, Station Road, ST HELENS JUNCTION STATION Bus Facility, Station Road, Robin's Lane, Baxter's Lane, Sutton Road, Marshall's Cross Road, Eltonhead Road to MARSHALLS CROSS (LEA GREEN STATION).

**Return** via reverse of above route to Parr (Derbyshire Hill Road/Fleet Lane).
